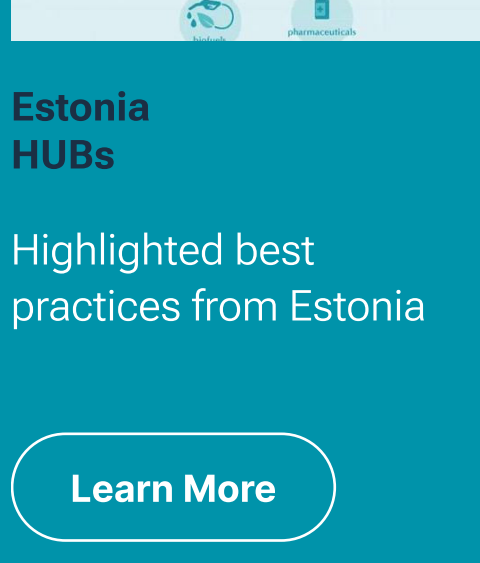

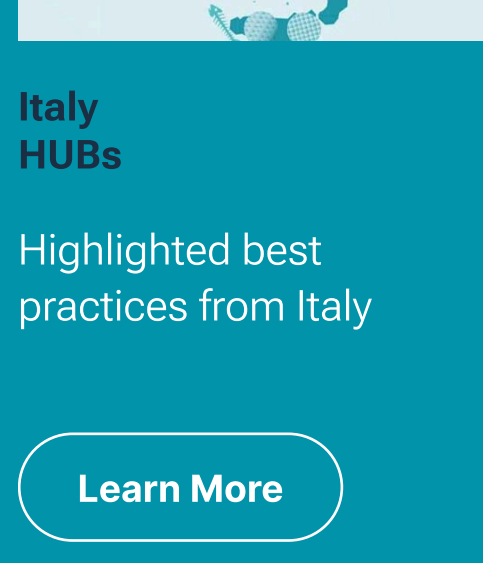

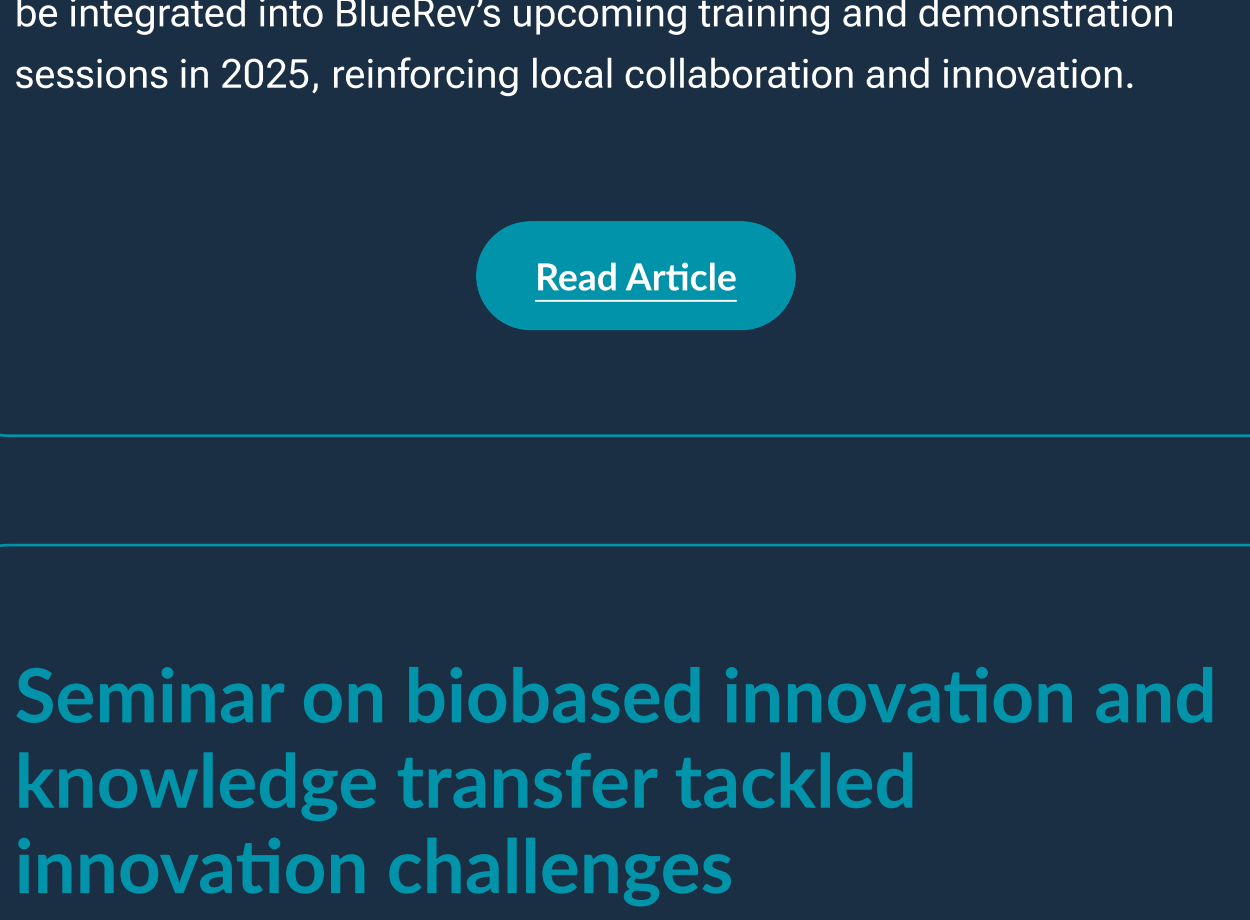
Young Ocean Advocate in BlueRev partnership

Estonian stakeholders' workshop addressed innovation on blue bioeconomy in Saaremaa context

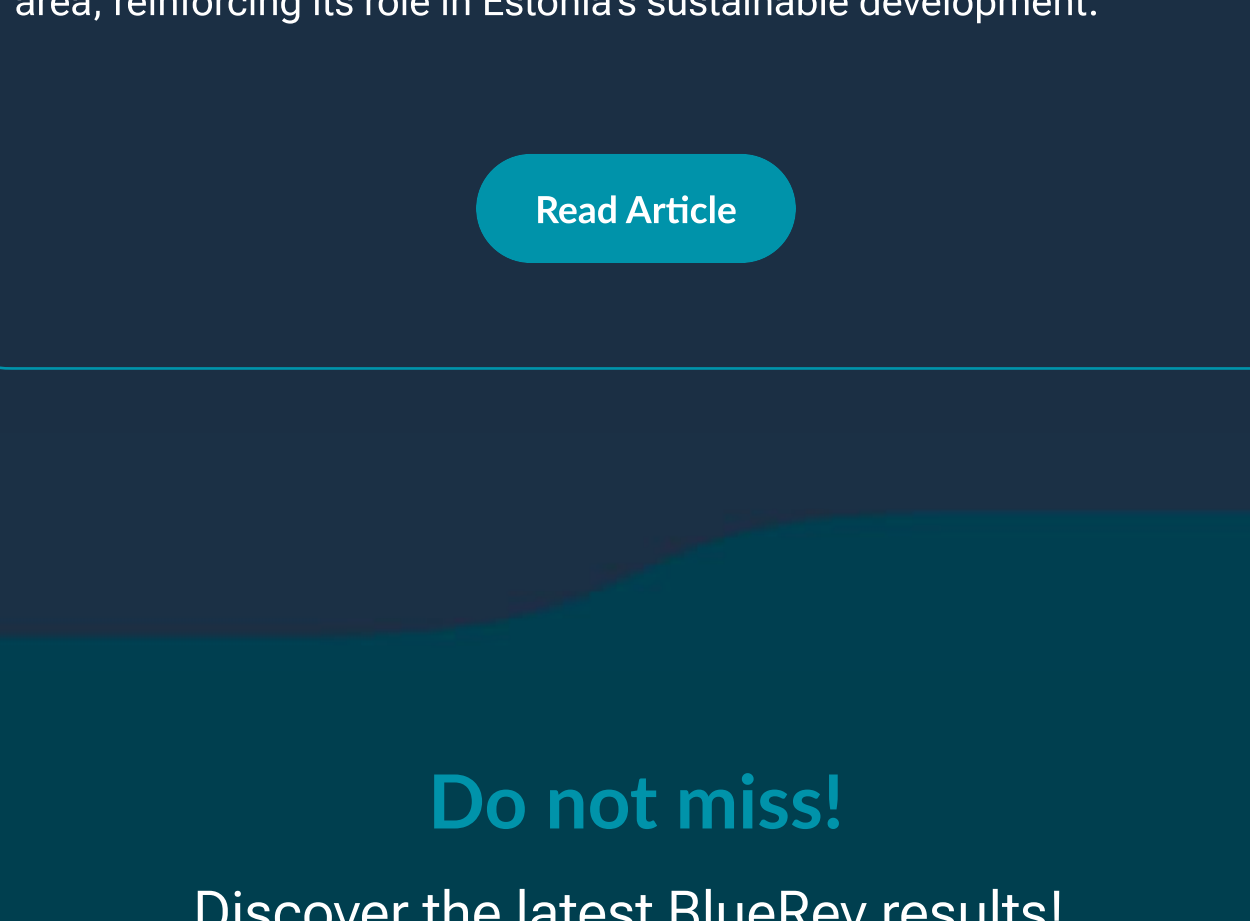


On November 4th, the Estonian University of Life Sciences and TalTech Kuressaare College hosted the "Blue Bioeconomy and Innovation" workshop in Saaremaa, bringing together local and virtual stakeholders to validate BlueRev's work on governance and social innovation. Discussions focused on governance priorities, stakeholder activation, and innovative blue bioresource use in the region.

Researchers also showcased cutting-edge projects, including horticultural byproducts for fish feed, microalgae biomolecule extraction, and aquaponics systems. Insights from the workshop will be integrated into BlueRev's upcoming training and demonstration sessions in 2025, reinforcing local collaboration and innovation.

Seminar on biobased innovation and knowledge transfer tackled innovation challenges



On October 17th, the Estonian University of Life Sciences hosted a seminar on innovation and knowledge transfer for the bioeconomy and circular practices, organized by its Center of Bioeconomy. Anne Põder presented BlueRev's insights on blue bioeconomy challenges in Western Estonia, highlighting governance fragmentation, regulatory hurdles, and the need for multiuse cooperation models in marine space. Discussions also covered microalgae farming, sustainable feed additives, and invasive species valorization. The circular bioeconomy roadmap for the region identified the blue bioeconomy as a key focus area, reinforcing its role in Estonia's sustainable development.

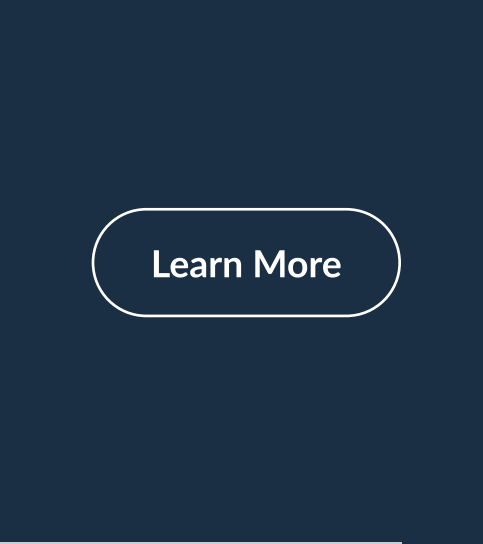
