#### Advancing Sustainable Innovation in the Blue Bioeconomy

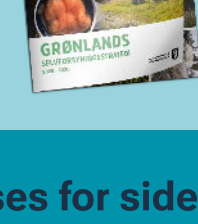

The 58th European Marine Biology Symposium will take place in Bodø, Norway, from 6–9 July 2025, hosted by Nord University in partnership with the EuroMarine Network.
